EJ: Do you recall any school performances or community parades or anything like that?

PC: Lynn Valley Days was always held on the big field, Lynn Valley Park, which was attached to our school. That was huge. And the parades. There was a gentleman who used to live in Lynn Valley, and I don't remember his name, but he was a cowboy. And he used to dress up as a cowboy and bring his horse to school every now and then. And I just remember that we would crowd around and want to touch the horse. And he would tell us stories about old days in North Vancouver - I don't remember any, but I do remember he had this big mustache. He always led the Lynn Valley Parade.

PC: And we were always in the parade, too. You'd decorate your bike and rode in the parade. It was a big deal.
