### COAST SALISH WOOL WEAVING AND GUIDED GALLERY EXPERIENCE

This two-part program features a hands-on workshop on Coast Salish wool weaving led by one of MONOVA's Indigenous Cultural Programmers. Participants will discover the importance of wool weaving in Coast Salish culture, past and present, and the teachings that surround it while producing a simple, yet beautiful bracelet. This is accompanied by a guided tour of the gallery, highlighting stories, objects, belongings and photographs from communities on the North Shore.



### YARROW SALVE MAKING AND GUIDED GALLERY EXPERIENCE

A useful and versatile medicinal plant, yarrow provides pain relief, stops bleeding and prevents infection. An Indigenous Cultural Programmer will guide participants in making their own yarrow salve, beginning with harvesting from MONOVA's garden. This is accompanied by a guided tour of the gallery, highlighting stories, objects, belongings and photographs from communities on the North Shore.



### COAST SALISH CANVAS PAINTING AND GUIDED GALLERY EXPERIENCE

Learn about Coast Salish culture and teachings through art in this canvas painting session with one of our Indigenous Cultural Programmers. Participants will be guided through a hands-on exploration of different Coast Salish styles, motifs and methods. All art supplies are included. This is accompanied by a guided tour of the gallery, highlighting stories, objects, belongings and photographs from communities on the North Shore.



### TEA AND TOUR: MUSEUM

Experience the history of the North Shore, and the ways in which MONOVA preserves, elevates, and brings local stories to the community. Take a guided tour of the Museum, followed by tea and refreshments and an opportunity to discuss our work and our collections with a staff member (also available at the Archives).

## RIDING WITH CHANGE AND GUIDED GALLERY EXPERIENCE

This 30-minute, one-person museum theatre piece explores Streetcar 153, its riders, and the pivotal role streetcars played on the North Shore from the early 20th century. Step back and forth in time, investigating the stories the streetcar has to tell about how our community changed during its impressive 35-year career. Afterwards, our Actor-Interpreter will share some archival photographs and be available for discussion. This is accompanied by a guided tour of the gallery, highlighting stories, objects, belongings and photographs from communities on the North Shore.



## MOUNTAINEER PALS AND GUIDED GALLERY EXPERIENCE

Mountaineers Molly and Max will thrill your group with tales of daring adventure and rescue from the early days of mountaineering on the North Shore. In this 30-minute, interactive theatrical piece, you'll encounter some of the North Shore's most adventurous residents—mountaineers, rescue team members, skiers, and climbers. This piece is accompanied by a guided tour of the gallery, highlighting stories, objects, belongings and photographs from communities on the North Shore.
